Thanks to You the Pet Food Bank is a Lifeline

Because of you, the OHS Emergency Pet Food Bank helps pet owners who have nowhere else to turn. Unexpected crisis can impact anyone and leave them wondering where their next meal — or their pet's — will come from. A community member recently reached out to us with a message that hits close to home for many: "I have never been in this position before. My heart is broken. I have no one else to ask for help and no other food in the house that is suitable to provide as a temporary meal for the dogs. It's been very tight since I lost my job."

Helping Pets and Families in Crisis

Your generous support makes OHS wellness clinics possible, providing wellness exams, core vaccinations, microchips, and other preventive veterinary services for pet owners who otherwise couldn't access them. The wellness clinics help lower the chance that a pet will need emergency veterinary care. You are preventing heartbreak for families in your community and ensuring the OHS is ready for animals with nowhere else to go.

Impacts of a Veterinary Shortage

You make sure there is always care and support for Ottawa's homeless animals. At the OHS, we're facing a veterinary shortage and haven't reached our target for pets sterilized through our Mobile Spay/Neuter Service.

We've shifted resources from our spay/neuter program to provide for the huge number of homeless animals who need our care.

We expect to get our spay/neuter service back on the road soon and provide this essential procedure where it's needed most.

Bucking Off Cruelty

You are building a more humane and compassionate community for all. More than 1,400 caring people spoke out in our recent petition against the exploitation of animals for profit and entertainment in bull riding events.

Bull riding competitions force bulls into a state of distress through a flank strap tied around the animal's waist and the rider saddled on the bull's back. Footage from a professional bull riding event in Ottawa shows riders slapping the bulls in the chute and the cruel conditions these creatures endure. Progress for the animals is only possible because of your support. It takes many voices of people who care to make a difference and to protect all animals in need.
